Camp Waupaca Opens For Third Season

Between 75 and 80 boys ranging in ages from 6 to 16 will begin an eight-week stay at Camp Waupaca on Stratton lake June 28.

The water front is being enlarged to accommodate 500 swimmers, according to the owners and operators, Irving "Skipper" Kuklin and Joe Rosen of Illinois. The majority of the boys are from Chicago and vicinity.

The private boys' camp, opened 2 years ago, is located on the northeast shore of Stratton lake, 6 1/2 miles southwest of Waupaca on 71 acres of the former Clarence Filles farm off of highway 22. All of the counselors are employed during the school year as teachers.
