1. BLIND BILLY'S RACE (G-Swim) Men are blindfolded and taken to the middle of the lake in lifejackets. They are dumped there and must swim to shore where an official blows a whistle every 30 seconds. Swimmers must tag the official before removing blindfold

MISS DOGPATCH CONTEST (Dinner) All contestants must wear bikinis and will be judged on style, beauty and figure development.

STRIPTEASE SWIM First man dressed in pants and shirt over bathing suit swims to raft, disrobes and swims back to shore where he tags second man. Second man swims to raft, dresses and swims back to shore. (any pair of pants and shirt may be used by second man.)

MULESKINNERS WAR Each man paddles a phayak in the swimmers area with his hands and tries to tip over the other clans. Last clan afloat wins.

> CREASY WATERMELLON SHUFFLE Non-swimmer carries greased watermellon from towel racks to another non-swimmer at water's edge. Second non-swimmer carries watermellon to beginner's ropes where a beginner takes it to the swimmers ropes. Swimmer takes it to far ropes where another swimmer returns it to the beginner who gives it to the non-swimmer. First watermellon to reach towel

racks wins. (Water mellon must still be in one piece) Darrotton MOONSHINER'S RACE Two men from each clan must paddle a caroe past federal agents to pick up a gallon of moonshine from a boat in the lake. They must return it to shore where four other members of their clan must drink

> SUPER CHICKEN JOUST Two teams from each clan ride on their partners shoulders in the begginers area. Each clan tries to unseat the others. Last clan standing wins.

PONY EXPRESS AND STAGE COACH RELAY Two members of each clan paddle a third member in a canoe to rowboats stationed in the lake. Passenger is transfered to the rowboats and returned to shore by two rowers.

RIDGE RUNNER RELAY Entire clan lines up along the waterfront from the boat dock to the swimming area. They must toss a raw egg to a man who takes it to the begginers ropes. Another man takes it to the swimmers ropes where a swimmer takes it to the raft. The last man must swim from the raft to the shore with the egg. (If the egg is broken at any point in the race, the clan must start over from the boat dock.)
